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Eligible athletes:

All athletes must comply with the provisions of the Olympic Charter currently in force, and only those athletes who have complied with the Olympic Charter may participate in the Youth Olympic Games.

To be eligible to participate in the Youth Olympic Games, athletes must have been born between 1 January 1997 and 31 December 1998.

Athletes must also be entered by attending the race briefing to one of the following events:

- 2014 Continental YOG Qualifying Event,
- 2013 Continental Championships or 2014 Continental Championships (in case it is held before 8 June 2014).

Athletes must be entered in qualifying competitions by their NOCs, which must have respective National Federations in good standing with the ITU.

ITU will confirm the eligibility of the selected athletes after the NOC communication of the name(s)

Reallocation of unused quota places

Extract from Point F from the 2014 Youth Olympic Games Qualification Criteria

UNUSED IF QUOTA PLACES

Any unused place will go to the next NOC with no qualified athletes on a roll down of the results of the specific Continental YOG Qualifying event where the place was obtained. (...)

UNUSED HOST COUNTRY PLACES

If the host nation achieves qualification through the Asian YOG Qualifying event, place 32 will be returned to the next eligible athlete at the Asian Continental YOG Qualifying Event. (...)

UNUSED NOC UNIVERSALITY PLACES

Any unused Universality Places, including those returned after the final allocation by the YOG Tripartite Commission will go to the next NOC with no qualified athletes on a roll down of the results at the NOC's Continental YOG Qualifying event, in the following order of priority of continents: 1-Americas, 2-Asia, 3-Africa, 4-Europe, 5-Oceania. (...)
